June 28, 1941 - December 29, 2020

On the morning of Tuesday, December 29, 2020, Master Sergeant (Retired), U.S. Army Reserves, Jesse Will Ussery received his last Permanent Duty Station (PDS) to heaven. Another soldier gone home to rest. Jesse was born in Steens, Lowndes County, Mississippi on June 28, 1941 to the late James Ussery and Alberta (Hudson) Ussery.
