She attended Oktibbeha Webster Schools in Maben, Mississippi from 1960 to 1970. She united with Mary Holmes Junior College Presbyterian Church during her elementary school years. In 1970 she attended Starkville High School until 1972 when she graduated.

Marcia attended the University of Southern Mississippi from 1972 to 1977. Upon the completion of two degrees at USM, she married Troy L. Foster, Jr. of Picayune, Mississippi. They lived in several towns and cities as they each pursued their separate careers. She taught for eleven years in the public school system in Texas.

In 2002 she moved to Lowndes County. Because of her love for children and family, she became a volunteer in the Wicks Community 4-H Club Organization. She also became a member of the family church, New Zion M.B. Church.

Marcia's health continued to deteriorate, but she was a fighter and strong willed person. She would always say, "I am not ready to throw the towel in, just yet."
