



Dr. Oscar L. Logan

March 30, 1950 - August 18, 2021

Dr. Oscar L. Logan passed away on August 18, 2021 at Baptist Memorial Hospital in Columbus, MS.

Dr. Logan was born to Willie Mae Logan and Walker Hargrove on March 30, 1950 in Columbus, MS. He accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at St. Matthew M.B. Church under the leadership of the late Reverend J. H. Cockrell.

Dr. Logan attended Motley Elementary School. He graduated from R.E. Hunt High in 1968. He graduated from Jackson State University in 1971 with a Bachelor's degree in art education. While at Jackson State University, he was involved in the Athenian Art Club and the Interfaith Choir. He also attended Indiana University - Purdue and Herron Art School in Indianapolis. While in Indiana, he worked as a substitute art teacher in the Indianapolis Public School System. He also worked as a staff counselor at Indiana Health Careers and as a teacher at Shortridge High School. In 1975, he graduated with a Master's degree in art education from the University of Wisconsin - Madison. He also obtained a Master's degree in art sculpture in 1976 from the University of Wisconsin - Madison. He completed his doctoral degree in 1982 from the University of Wisconsin in art education. For more than 23 years, Dr. Logan worked at Alabama A&M University in Huntsville, AL as an art professor. His creative paintings and sculptures were featured in many

exhibits, magazines, and newspapers.

Dr. Logan met and married Dr. Jane L. Ford. To that union, one child was born Jarad Ford Logan. He had a lifelong love of art, food, music, and travel. An extensive traveler, Dr. Logan visited various countries including the Bahamas, China, Jamaica, Japan, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Over the years, he developed many friendships. He loved talking on the phone with his close friends and spending time with his family.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by one nephew, Kevin Levon Morris.

Dr. Logan leaves many to cherish his memory. He is survived by his son, Jarad F. Logan of Huntsville, AL; his grandson, Niles Ford Logan of Huntsville, AL; one brother, Earnest "Ray" (Betty) Logan of Caledonia, MS; one sister, Mattie "Ree" (Jessie – a dedicated brother-in-law) Morris of Columbus, MS; five nephews, Earnest "Darren" (Rena) Logan, Edward (Daphne) Logan, and Alex (Jaynesia) Morris all of Columbus, MS, Jesse (Jasmine) Morris of Conyers, GA, and Erick (Tyronica) Logan of Pontotoc, MS; and his nieces, Renee (George) Pruitt of Caledonia, MS and Adrienne Morris of Columbus, MS. 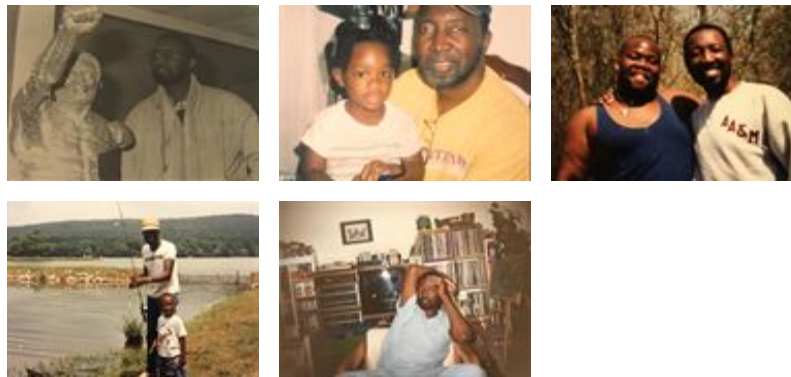
